Some highlights for the July 22nd market:

It's Maui Chamber of Commerce Member Day at the market this Friday! At each tent, just present ID (business card, employee badge) showing that you're employed by a business that's a current member of the Maui Chamber of Commerce and you'll receive a discount or other "special offer" from that vendor!

The **Farm Bureau Tents** will feature more than a dozen local farmers' produce, including Maui honey and natural cane sugar! Need zucchini? How about mint? Kohlrabi? Eggplant? Kale? Organic papaya? Chinese cabbage? We've got it!

- A large variety of **Maui's best greens, lettuces and tomatoes** are available at Aloha Friday Farmers Market this week and every week. Some of these products are not typically available for sale to the public.

Perfect for a late lunch or take-home dinner: Maui Chili made by Maui Culinary Arts students with donated beef from Maui Cattle Company will be served from 1:00 - 6:00 this Friday!

Ono Organic Farms of Hana, **Yee's Orchard** of Kihei, and **Maui Tropical Plantation** of Wailuku have donated produce for fruit smoothies at this Friday's market. Maui Culinary Academy students will use the donated papaya, apple bananas, mangos and strawberries to create the freshest smoothies on Maui. The **Smoothie Bar** will be open from 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. outside the Pa'ina Building entrance. (Also, grill service, sandwiches, and salads are available from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. inside the Pa'ina Building.)

Wonderful **Made In Maui** vendors are also at the market. This week check out: **Maui Rose Soaps** – All-natural fine bath soaps, body butters, and gift sets. Dozens of scents, from flowery tuberose to earthy lava flow, all handmade in

Haiku.
